TASTING NOTES

"The Bonarda variety is very popular in Argentina, especially in Mendoza. The idea of this Special Edition is to show another expression of this variety from La Brava Estate vineyards, located in Cafayate, at 1,700 meters", says Thibaut Delmotte, Winemaker of Colomé Winery.

Ruby colored with purple hues, the nose highlights black and red fruits with a spicy mint. Concentrated and complex, it is fresh, with good volume on the palate.
