Sauvignon Blanc 2017

Description:

Intense aromas of tropical fruits, with an elegant touch of flowers, making this wine very delicate. On the palate it is fresh and fruity with good acidity.

Winemaker's Notes:

The grapes for this wine come from Molina area, close to the Andes Mountains in Curicó Valley. These are hand-picked at the middle of March, the grapes are crushed and afterwards there is a cold maceration (8°C) in press for 2 hours. After that, Alcoholic Fermentation takes place at controlled temperatures (12-14°C) during 25 days, where it is always protected from air contact.

Serving Tips:

Perfect as an aperitif, and ideal to accompany fish, seafood, white wine sauces and pasta dishes.
