Notes from Harvest:

The 2016 growing season in Napa Valley started early, saw ideal weather conditions throughout and wrapped up as the valley's first significant fall rainstorm arrived on October 14th. Temperatures were relatively steady and mild in July and August, with a series of warm days ending the growing season that promoted perfect ripeness.

Tasting Notes:

Very aromatic with ripe cherries, cocoa and hints of oak spice. It's medium-bodied and very well balanced, showing nice acidity and somewhat polished tannins for an extremely inviting mouthfeel.
