The 2022 County Line Rosé gleams bright in the glass with an inviting salmon-colored hue. Tangy aromas of kumquat zest join notes of alpine strawberry, yellow nectarine, and narcissus blossom. A racy acidity weaves throughout the smooth and rounded palate, complementing mouthwatering layers of summer-ripened fruit. Dancing across the lasting, refreshing finish is a delicate salinity, tempting another flavorsome sip. Chill and enjoy with crispy fish tacos or fresh watermelon salad with feta and cucumber. County Line originated from a desire to provide cool-climate appellation snapshots of the Anderson Valley, Sonoma Coast, Russian River, and North Coast. A companion label since 2003, the team at Radio-Coteau utilizes low-intervention winemaking techniques and a shorter élevage in neutral French oak barrels, concrete eggs, or stainless steel to craft approachable, food-friendly wines. In partnering with select growers in Mendocino and Sonoma who are committed to organic farming practices, the name County Line was inspired by our frequent trips across those counties' borders.

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
