2019 Old Paddock 1921 Vines Shiraz

First planted by Maurice O’Shea in 1921, the vineyard was propagated using cuttings from Mount Pleasant’s Old Hill vineyard first planted in 1880. The perfect site for shiraz, the block sits mid-way up a gentle rise and is sheltered from the afternoon sun and wind, providing a wine abundant in fruit richness, natural tannin, and power.

Tasting Notes

Deep purple in colour, a complex aroma of dark fruits and spice with a palate of intense fruits, beautiful tannin structure and impeccably balanced acidity.

Drinking Window

This wine has the freshness to drink young, and the pedigree and chemistry to age gracefully over the next 40 years.
