



2021 Mount Henry Shiraz Pinot

Australia's unique blend crafted by Maurice O'Shea in 1937 has now become a cult hero among wine lovers. Sourced from our own vineyards, the shiraz is lightly framed and blended with pinot noir from our 100-year-old block, providing a wine of balance, complexity, and finesse. Mount Pleasant revived this blend in the late 1990s and it has since been emulated across all regions in Australia for its amazing complexity.

Tasting Notes

Sweet red berries, spice and rose petals on the nose, boasting flavours of dark berries on the palate with finegrained, chalky tannins.

Drinking Window

The Mount Henry is designed to drink in its youth, however, recent examples have shown the ability to age for greater than 20 years.
