<b>colour</b>	pale straw/hints of green
<b>aroma</b>	stone fruit, citrus, cashew + hints of toasty oak
<b>palate</b>	white peach, lemon, textural, crisp, dry finish
<b>cellar</b>	5 - 10 years
<b>nutrition</b>	95 calories per 120ml glass, vegan

### Viticulture

<b>region</b>	Yarra Valley
<b>vineyard</b>	sourced from select vineyards in Dixons Creek, Yarra Glen, Coldstream, Gladysdale, Gruyere + Chirnside Park
<b>harvest</b>	early march
<b>method</b>	hand + machine picked

### Winemaking

<b>process</b>	combination of whole bunch pressed + destemmed/crushed parcels
<b>fermentation</b>	partial solids fermented in barrel then aged for 10 months
<b>maloactic</b>	10.0%
<b>alcohol</b>	12.8%
<b>winemakers</b>	Rob Dolan + Adrian Santolin

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
