<b>Aroma</b>	Cranberry, cherry, violets
<b>Palate</b>	Choc raspberry, baking spice, velvety tannins
<b>Cellar</b>	Zero to 8 years

### Viticulture

<b>Region</b>	Yarra Valley
<b>Vineyard</b>	A blend of valley floor vineyards
<b>Harvest</b>	4 to 9 March 2023
<b>Method</b>	Machine harvested

### Winemaking

<b>Process</b>	Destemmed + crushed, some whole bunch. Cold settled, racked to oak (50%).
<b>Fermentation</b>	Fermented cool in first and second use French oak (50%). Balance stainless steel.
<b>Oak</b>	50% matured for 6 months.
<b>Alcohol</b>	13.0%
