Notes from Harvest:

February saw abundant rains. Bud break and flowering occurred a bit late, but under ideal weather conditions, creating plentiful and even fruit set. Summer was virtually uninterrupted by major heat spikes. The relatively mild temperatures followed by extended fall sunshine and moderate heat created near-ideal conditions for fruit to accumulate flavor complexity with gradual increases in sugar levels.

Tasting Notes:

Aromas of ripe cherries, watermelon, cranberry and under currents of pencil shavings. It has a mix of fresh ripe berries on the palate with elegant tannins and a soft lingering finish. This medium-bodied wine has perfect balance between its flavor profile, tannin structure and natural acidity. Drink now or over the next 15 years.
